SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- Heidi Grace Sweet Whimsy:
 - Specialty papers
 - Paper pad
 - Punchboard pad
 - Accents
 - Rub-ons
- Ribbon
- Craft knife
- Paper trimmer
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- Adhesive dots
- Hole punch
- Scoring tool
- Cardstock: lavender, pink, green
- Pencil

DIRECTIONS: Refer to photo.**HOUSE**

1. Punch 4 large frames from the punchboard pad. Using the sturdy front & back covers of the pad, trace 2 frames side-by-side; these will become 2 sides of the house. Trim, score; fold. Repeat for other 2 sides.
2. For each side of the house, cut a paper slightly larger than the inside dimension of the frames. Glue the printed paper to the back of frame with pattern showing through the frame. Glue the scored panels and top each one with a large frame.
3. Add windows, window boxes, flowers & mushroom door. Cut door open with craft knife.
4. Cut house peaks from the paper-covered punchboard. Attach the peaks to the front and back of the house. Assemble the house using tape and more sturdy front and back covers.
5. Punch 2 border strips from the punchboard pad. Adhere to the bottom edge of the house.

ROOF

1. Cut snail from oversized pink & yellow flower from the paper pad; set aside.
2. Score flower for the roof; fold in half. Glue it to lavender cardstock & trim, leaving a lavender border that will increase the overall size by 1/2". Bend layers into a roof shape, while glue is still damp. Set aside.

BASE

1. Glue the oversized pink & green flower to green cardstock. Trim the edges, leaving a green border that will increase the overall size by 1/2".
2. To make an entryway rug, remove a square from the paper pad & glue it to the Base flower, just inside the Fairy House door. Glue stepping stones outside the door.

SNAIL

1. Glue patterned paper to the wrong side of the snail, leaving 1/2" remaining at the bottom; score and fold to serve as a stand. Position snail by front door or on roof.

FAIRIES

1. For each fairy, create a cardstock tent in a coordinating color. Make each tent an inch or more wider & taller than the rub-on Fairies. Score & fold the tents. Rub on fairies, flowers & hearts. Trim tent smaller if desired. Attach short ribbon to the inside of each tent with adhesive dots.

FINISHING

Set the house on the base. Lay the roof on the house. Arrange fairies by the front door.
