



decorative wall panels

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SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- Styrofoam™ brand foam sheets, 12"x12"x1" (use one for each panel)
- Sobo glue
- 1" Paint brush
- Water in small container
- 7/8" Straight pins
- Scissors
- Ruler

DIRECTIONS:

PAPER-COVERED PANEL

1. Following directions on StyroCutter® Plus, cut foam sheet 10"x10"x1". Cut scrapbook paper 10"x10".
2. Using a mixture of 1 part water and 2 parts Sobo glue, apply glue mixture to top surface of panel with paint brush. Place paper on the top and press in place. Dry upside down on washable slick surface, weighing it down with heavy books or magazines. Dry thoroughly.
3. At the bottom edge of the foam block, pin end of 7/8" ribbon with two pins. Note: Dip all pin points in StyroGlue® before pinning them into the ribbon. Wrap ribbon around the perimeter of the panel, placing a pin midway along each side. Pull ribbon tight as you proceed. At the end, fold ribbon under 1/4" and pin with two pins. Repeat using the 5/8" ribbon placed on the top edge of the block and overlapping the 7/8" ribbon completely covering the edge.
4. Using a small paint brush or toothpick, cover the pin heads with a dab of black paint. Let dry before hanging.

• StyroGlue®

- For fabric-covered panels: 18"x18" fabrics, one for each panel
- For paper-covered panels: 12"x12" Scrapbook paper 42" each 7/8" wide ribbon & 5/8" wide ribbon Black acrylic paint Small paint brush or tooth pick StyroCutter® Plus

FABRIC-COVERED PANEL

1. Using a mixture of 1 part water and 3 parts Sobo glue, apply glue mixture to top surface of foam panel with paint brush.
2. Lay fabric, right side down, on a flat surface. Turn foam panel glue side down and place in center of the fabric. Make sure fabric is straight and there is a 3" edge of fabric all around panel.
3. Press down on back then turn over and smooth surface with hands. Let dry right side up.
4. Turn panel upside down. Starting along one edge, pull fabric tightly over edge to the back and pin in about five places dipping all pin points in StyroGlue® before pinning them into fabric. Repeat this step with the opposite edge.
5. Fold remaining sides at corners as if wrapping a package and pin corners and edges. Fold edges up and over block end and pin securely using as many pins as necessary. Place a pin at each corner of outside of block. Repeat these steps with the remaining blocks.
