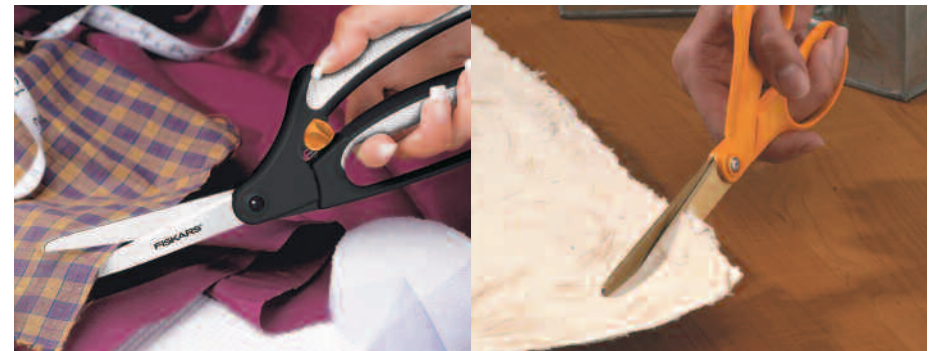

Tips for Cutting with Scissors

- Use the correct scissors for the task.
- Never force a cut if you sense resistance — this can disturb the setting of the blades. If you cannot cut through the material you may be using the wrong scissors for the task.
- If your hands get tired from large cutting tasks and projects, consider spring-action scissors. The spring-action design gently opens itself after every cut, eliminating extra hand motion and pressure.
