### **FLEECE BLANKET**

### **SUPPLIES & TOOLS:**

- 2 yds fleece for top layer of blanket
- 2 yds contrasting fleece for bottom layer of blanket
- Matching thread

- Sewing machine
- Basic sewing supplies
- Rotary cutter, mat & ruler

# **DIRECTIONS:**

- 1. Place the top and bottom fleece wrong sides together and pin 6" in from edges to secure the pieces together.
- 2. Trim selvages from bottom layer; square off edges.
- 3. Mark top piece 3" in from edge of bottom layer and cut so top layer is 3" smaller all around.
- 4. To achieve the binding look, fold bottom layer 3" edge over top layer and fold corners to form a mitered corner. Pin in place.
- 5. Top stitch through all thicknesses.

### **FLEECE FLOWER PILLOWS**

#### **SUPPLIES & TOOLS:**

- Simplicity® pattern 5105
- Fleece fabric for pillow front and back (see pattern)
- 1/3 yd contrasting fleece for inner flower
- 1/4 yd contrasting fleece for flower center
- Embroidery floss
- Basic sewing supplies
- Sewing machine
- 16-oz Polyester stuffing

# **DIRECTIONS:**

- 1. Using Simplicity® pattern 5105, cut out front and back of flower pillow.
- 2. Using the pattern as a guide, draw a flower approximately 3" smaller than the pattern.
- 3. Cut out a circle for the center.
- 4. Pin center to flower and flower to pillow, then blanket stitch in place.
- 5. Follow pattern directions for sewing and stuffing.
