craft foam animal masks

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# **SUPPLIES & TOOLS:**

• 9"x12" or 12"x18" craft foam sheets

See patterns to determine size needed:

White: for cow, sheep

Black: for cow, horse, pig

Pink: for cow, sheep

Light pink: for pig

Dark pink: for pig

Brown, 2 shades: for horse

Tan: for cow

Yellow: for duck

Orange: for duck

- Black permanent felt-tip marker
- Sharp scissors
- Craft foam glue
- 1/8" Hole punch
- Yarn: two 16" lengths for each mask, in coordinating colors

### **DIRECTIONS:**

### COW:

- 1. Enlarge mask patterns 200% on photocopier; cut out.
- 2. Use pattern to cut 1 head from black foam. Cut 1 nose from white foam. Cut 2 nose holes from black foam. Cut 2 inside ears from pink foam. Cut 2 horns from tan foam. Referring to photo for placement, glue nose onto head, nose holes onto nose, inside ears onto outer ears and horns onto top of head.
- 3. Using marker, draw mouth.
- 4. Cut out eye holes.
- 5. Punch one hole on either side of mask. Thread yarn through holes, knotting one end to secure.

# DUCK:

- 1. Enlarge mask patterns 200% on photocopier; cut out.
- 2. Use pattern to cut 1 head from yellow foam. Cut 1 bill from orange foam.
- 3. Referring to photo for placement, glue bill onto head.
- 4. Using marker, draw nose or bill holes.
- 5. Cut out eye holes.
- 6. Punch one hole on either side of mask. Thread yarn through holes, knotting one end to secure.



# **DIRECTIONS** (continued):

#### HORSE:

- 1. Enlarge mask patterns 200% on photocopier; cut out.
- 2. Use pattern to cut 1 head from darker brown foam. Cut 2 inside ears from black foam. Cut 2 nose holes from black foam. Cut 1 muzzle from lighter brown foam. Referring to photo for placement, glue inside ears onto outer ears, muzzle onto lower head and nose holes onto muzzle.



- 3. Using marker, draw mouth and mane at the top of the head between ears.
- 4. Cut out eye holes.
- 5. Punch one hole on either side of mask. Thread yarn through holes, knotting one end to secure.

#### PIG:

- 1. Enlarge mask patterns 200% on photocopier; cut out.
- 2. Use pattern to cut 1 head from light pink foam. Cut 2 inner ears and snout from dark pink foam. Cut 2 snout holes from black foam. Referring to photo for placement, glue inner ears to outer ears, snout on face and snout holes onto snout.




- 3. Using marker, draw mouth.
- 4. Cut out eye holes.
- 5. Punch one hole on either side of mask. Thread yarn through holes, knotting one end to secure.


# SHEEP:


- 1. Enlarge mask patterns 200% on photocopier; cut out.
- 2. Use pattern to cut 1 head from white foam. Cut 2 inside ears from pink foam.
- 3. Referring to photo for placement, glue inside ears to outer ears.
- 4. Using marker, draw mouth, nose and curls on the top of the head.
- 5. Cut out eye holes.
- 6. Punch one hole on either side of mask. Thread yarn through holes, knotting one end to secure.















