#### DIRECTIONS FOR GIRL ONESIES:

1. Machine wash and dry Onesies. *Do not use fabric softener.*
2. Cut "Sweet" and "Baby Girl" words from transfer sheet.
3. Using photo as your guide for placement, position baby face and word transfer designs face down on Onesies.
4. Remove water from iron. Set iron temperature to the cotton setting. Iron transfer designs for approximately 60-80 seconds. Allow to cool. Gently and slowly remove backing paper. *For best results, iron on a clean, hard surface.*

#### DIRECTIONS FOR BOY ONESIES:

1. Machine wash and dry Onesies. *Do not use fabric softener.*
2. Cut "Cutie Pie!" and "Baby Boy" words from transfer sheet. Cut "Baby Boy" into separate words.
3. Using photo as your guide for placement, position baby face and word transfer designs face down on Onesies.
4. Remove water from iron. Set iron temperature to the cotton setting. Iron transfer designs for approximately 60-80 seconds. Allow to cool. Gently and slowly remove backing paper. *For best results, iron on a clean, hard surface.*
