

## kids' school bus badge



## SUPPLIES \& TOOLS:

- 12"xl2" Cardstock \& papers:

Cardstock, in turquoise and yellow
Striped paper
Vellum

- Xyron ${ }^{\circledR}$ machine with laminating cartridge
- 4 large Buttons
- Embroidery floss \& needle
- 2 Brads
- Adhesive tabs
- Stickers: Clear Glitter, Letters, Numeral
- Vellum tape
- Hole punches: large \& standard hole
- Scissors
- Photos
- Velcro ${ }^{\circledast}$ strip
- Safety pins
- School bus pattern (less than 5 " to fit through laminator)


## DIRECTIONS:

1. Using school bus pattern, cut 2 from striped paper, facing in opposite directions. Trim, if necessary, so they are exactly the same shape, when placed wrong sides together.
2. Mount one bus onto turquoise cardstock and trim around edges, leaving a small margin. Flip over, and mount the second striped school bus.
3. Cut vellum windows and mount on yellow cardstock; attach to bus and add a photo. Repeat on the other side with turquoise cardstock.
4. Attach stickers to both sides of buses to list relevant information such as bus number, room number, etc. Add decorative stickers around photos.
5. Stitch through each button with coordinating embroidery floss. Knot on the back. Set aside.
6. Place bus sides back to back and laminate using Xyron ${ }^{\circledR}$ machine; trim edges. Punch 2 standard holes in the wheels. Position a button over the punched hole and insert a brad. Flip the bus over and slip on the second button. Flatten the brad. Repeat for the other set of buttons.
7. Design tip: Attach photos of pets or family members in the other windows.
8. Add a strip of Velcro ${ }^{\oplus}$ or a safety pin to attach to backpack or notebook.
