







handpainted wood projects

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DECORATIVE INLAY BOXES

SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- Walnut Hollow® Inlay Boxes: Circle, Oblique, Cross, Rosette
- Delta Ceramcoat® Paint: Bittersweet Orange, White, Paradise, Apple Green, Sunbright Yellow
- Brushes: small round, small, medium flat, stencil
- Paper towel
- Sandpaper
- Spray varnish
- 3M® magic tape



DIRECTIONS:

- 1. To prepare boxes for painting, use sandpaper to lightly sand entire surface of each box. Remove dust with a paper towel.
- 2. Refer to photo for suggestions for color placement.
- 3. Use small round brush to apply paint to inlay sections. Use a small flat brush to apply paint to the tops of the inlay designs. Use a medium sized flat brush to apply paint to larger areas of boxes, inside and out.
- 4. To create stripes, use tape to insure a straight line. Be sure that paint is thoroughly dry before applying tape.

 Use a small flat brush or stencil brush to apply paint inside taped area.
- 5. To create dots, dip the wooden end of the paint brush into a small amount of paint. Hold brush perpendicular to box, touch surface and lift.
- 6. When paint is dry, apply 2-3 coats of spray varnish.

TISSUE BOX

SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- Walnut Hollow® Boutique Tissue Box
- Delta Ceramcoat® Paint: Gecko, Tahiti Blue, Brown Velvet, Crackle Medium
- Medium flat brush
- Paper towel
- Sandpaper
- Spray varnish

DIRECTIONS:

- To prepare the Tissue Box for painting, use sandpaper to lightly sand wood to a smooth finish. Remove dust with paper towel.
- 2. Use flat brush to apply Brown Velvet paint to entire wood surface. Let dry completely.
- 3. To apply Crackle Medium, follow directions on bottle. Use flat brush to apply one coat to two opposite sides of box. Let dry approximately 20-25 minutes or until tacky. With flat brush, apply one coat of Tahiti Blue paint over Crackle Medium. Paint will immediately start to crackle. Allow to dry.
- 4. Apply Crackle Medium to remaining opposite sides. After drying approximately 20-25 minutes, apply Gecko paint being careful not to get any paint on previously painted surfaces. Allow to dry.
- 5. Apply Crackle Medium to top and center rim of box. When tacky, apply Tahiti Blue paint.
- 6. Allow to dry thoroughly.
- 7. Apply 2-3 coats of spray varnish.

PAINTED BIRDHOUSE

SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- Birdhouse
- Wooden flower shape
- Acrylic paint: light aqua, yellow, bright pink
- Paint brushes: 1/2" flat, 1/4" flat
- Spray satin varnish, optional
- Sandpaper
- Tacky alue
- Tack cloth
- Paper towels



DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Paint birdhouse with one coat of paint in colors pictured. Let dry.
- 2. Sand lightly and wipe clean with tack cloth.
- 3. Apply second coat.
- 4. Paint wooden flower using pink for the petals and yellow for the center. When dry, dip the brush handle tip in aqua paint and dot the center of the flower.
- 5. Glue flower to front of birdhouse.
- 6. When dry, spray with varnish if desired.

Skill Level 1: No experience needed

Approximate Crafting Time: 1-2 hours plus drying time

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
