SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- Funkins[™] pumpkin
- 12"x12" Halloween paper pad
- Halloween mat pad papers
- Grand Adhesion stickers: ghost, pumpkin, haunted house
- Halloween pillow stickers
- 1½ sheets black cardstock
- Craft glitters: black, green & orange
- FolkArt® acrylic paints: Wicker White, Pure Orange, Pure Black & Fresh Foliage
- Paper mache boxes: 8" square, 12" hat
- Four 2" wooden knobs
- 2 yds black & white checked ribbon
- 2 yds of 3/4" black pompom trim
- 1 yd black twisted cording
- 9 black buttons
- 12"x12" cardboard
- 2 floral leaves
- Die-cutting machine & circle dies in 4 sizes
- Stretchable spider web
- Masking tape
- E-6000 & Zig 2-Way adhesives
- Mod Podge® matte finisher
- Craft knife
- Scallop-edge scissors
- Ruler
- LED tea light

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Paint wooden knobs with black paint & set aside for drying.
- 2. Place masking tape around hat box rim & rim of square box. Cover every other inch with masking tape.
- 3. Paint hat box orange. Paint square box white. Sprinkle each box with matching glitter while paint is wet.
- 4. Allow to dry. Remove tape. Carefully tape over painted area. Add black paint glitter to empty spots on rims.
- 5. Once dry, cover hat box lid with orange crow patterned paper; Cover square box lid with patterned paper.
- 6. To finish the hat box, cut three 3"x6" patterned papers and adhere around the box.
- 7. Divide the patterned paper with black cardstock cut to 1/4"x6". Each divider has been sprinkled with black glitter using Zig 2-Way adhesive. 12 dividers are needed.



- Embellish box with tombstones cut from patterned paper & back with cardboard. Add pillow sticker crossbones to one tombstone. Add black pompom trim to the lid of the box.
- 9. Cover 2 sides of square box with patterned paper & 2 sides with contrasting patterned paper.
- 10. Using scallop-edge scissors, add 1" patterned paper border around base. Cut 1/4" black cardstock border & glitter it with black glitter. Glue border to patterned paper scallop.
- 11. Attach painted wooden knobs with E-6000 adhesive.
- 12. Carve 7" circle from front of Funkins™ pumpkin. Paint carved out piece green. While paint is wet, add green glitter for base to go inside Funkins™ pumpkin.
- 13. Cut strips of patterned paper. Adhere inside.
- 14. Cut 8" circle from black patterned paper. Secure to inside back of Funkins™ pumpkin.
- 15. Cut tree from patterned paper. Adhere it to cardboard for stability. Place it in the Funkins™ pumpkin so owls can be secured outside. Cut tree smaller to fit inside Funkins™ pumpkin.
- 16. Secure ghost & pumpkin Grand Adhesion stickers.
- 17. Cut out the shape of the iron fence from patterned paper. Place in front of green glitter lid inside. Add paper but to the tree.
- 18. Adhere twisted cording around cut-out section of Funkins™ pumpkin. Add black buttons to cording.
- 19. Using the die-cutting machine, cut circles from black cardstock that has been glittered.
- 20. Paint Funkins™ pumpkin's stem with green paint and glitter it.
- 21. Tie black & white checkered ribbon to top of Funkins™ pumpkin. Add glitter leaves to stem. Place tea light & stretchable spider web inside.
