timmy tiger & mary monkey

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SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- Jungle Babies fleece panels: tiger and monkey family
- 3 bags 20-oz polyester fiberfill
- Wonder Invisible Thread
- Basic sewing supplies
- Sewing machine

DIRECTIONS:

TIMMY TIGER:

- 1. Cut out pieces of toy.
- 2. With right sides together, stitch around the curved area of the two ears.
- 3. Trim the seam allowance, being careful not to cut into the seam.
- 4. Turn the ear right side out. Fold to the notch and baste edge closed.





- 5. Pin the ears, matching the notches, to the head, with the white side of the ears lying on Timmy's face. Baste the ears in place, matching the notches.
- 6. Cut the lines on the top knot piece. Only cut to the end of the lines.
- 7. Fold top knot piece thirds. Stitch along attached area. Baste the top knot in place at the top of the head.
- 8. Right sides together, pin front & back of body together, with top knot and ears in between the two layers.







9. Stitch along seam allowance, leaving bottom open. Clip in all edges as marked, do not to cut the stitching.



- 10. Turn right side out and check all seams to make sure you don't have any white seam allowance showing.
- 11. Turn the body back wrong side out and continue.
- 12. Pin bottom oval in place, matching opening marks.
- 13. Stitch around bottom, leaving unstitched between the two notches at the back.
- 14. Stuff Timmy's body with the fiberfill.
- 15. Fold in the opening seam allowance between the notches, pin in place, and hand sew closed.
- 16. Tie knots in the top knot fringe, one at the base and one at the end of each fringe. This will make the top knot stand up.

MARY THE MONKEY:

- 1. Cut out all pieces of toy and keep in separate stacks. Right sides together, stitch around tail as marked.
- 2. Turn the tail right side out and stuff, using a chopstick or pencil.



- 3. Stitch the tail into the center back dart as marked.
- 4. Sew dart closed. Cut top knot along the solid lines making a fringe look, leaving all connected on one edge.



- 5. Fold the top knot piece in thirds.
- 6. Stitch together along attached area.
- 7. Baste in place at the top of the head as marked.
- 8. With top knot fringe to the inside, put the right sides of the body together. Pin together.



9. Stitch around the whole monkey, leaving the bottom open.



- 10. Turn right side out and check the seam to make sure no white seam allowance is showing.
- 11. Turn body wrong side out. Clip seams at the marks, being careful not to cut through the stitching.



- 12. Turn monkey body and ears right side out.
- 13. Stuff the ears lightly, with most of the stuffing to the outside edges.
- 14. Top-stitch along the dotted line between ears and the head.
- 15. Turn the body wrong side out and continue.
- 16. Pin bottom oval in place, matching opening marks.
- 17. Stitch around bottom, leaving unstitched between the two notches at the back.
- 18. Stuff monkey through opening.



19. Fold in the opening seam allowance between the notches, pin in place, and hand sew closed.



20. Tie knots in top knot fringe; one at the base & one at the end of each fringe to make top knot stand up.
