### SNOWMAN BAG EMBELLISHMENT SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- 3½"x10½" Christmas patterned paper, background
- 8"x7" White paper, head & body
- Two black brads, eyes
- 2"x3/4" Orange paper, nose
- 5"x7" Christmas patterned paper, scarf
- Six 6mm gold jump rings
- Four 20mm red bangle sequins with hole, scarf ends
- 5"x2½" Black paper, hat
- 7/8"x2½" Green paper, hat band
- Black marker

### DIRECTIONS:

1. Enlarge patterns approximately 400% and cut out. Trace patterns onto appropriate papers and cut out.
2. Glue background paper down middle of bag, leaving about 1" on each end of bag. Fold top end to inside of bag and glue; fold bottom end under bag and glue.
3. For body, glue white half-circle to lower part of bag, leaving about 1/2" to fold under and glue to bottom of bag.
4. For scarf, glue paper rectangle across top of body.
5. For scarf ends, cut two pieces of the same paper. Poke three holes at bottom of each. For each hole, open one jump ring, attach bangle sequin, slip through hole, and close jump ring.  
**Alternative:** Cut several slits at scarf ends to make fringe.
6. Glue scarf ends onto scarf.
7. Glue head onto top of body, just above scarf. For face, glue carrot nose to center of head and insert 2 brads for eyes above nose. Draw smiley mouth.

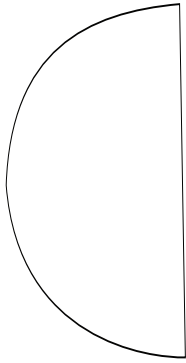
### REINDEER BAG EMBELLISHMENT SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- 3½"x10½" Christmas patterned paper, background
- 7"x7" brown paper, head, ears & body
- 4"x1¼" red paper, collar & nose
- Two black brads, eyes
- 1¼"x1¼" pink paper, cheek
- 6"x8" cream or tan paper, antlers
- Six 6mm gold jump rings, antlers
- Four 20mm multi color bangle sequins with hole, antlers

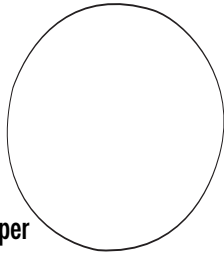
### DIRECTIONS:

1. Enlarge patterns approximately 400% and cut out. Trace patterns onto appropriate papers and cut out.
2. Glue background paper down middle of bag, leaving about 1" on each end of bag. Fold top end to inside of bag and glue; fold bottom end under bag and glue.
3. Glue body with neck to lower part of bag, leaving about 1/2" to fold and glue to bottom of bag.
4. For face: Glue red paper circle to end of nose. Glue pink paper circle to cheek. Insert 2 brads for eyes near top of face.
5. For ears, fold each brown circle in half and glue onto head.
6. Make 2 holes in each antler, refer to photo for position. For each hole, open one jump ring, attach bangle sequin, slip through hole and close jump ring.  
**Alternative:** Decorate antlers with glitter or beads to resemble Christmas lights.
7. Glue antlers to back of head. Glue head onto top of body.
8. Glue collar to bottom of neck.

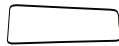
