Size: Monkey measures approximately 21 " long

## SUPPLIES \& TOOLS:

- Caron ${ }^{\circledR}$ One Pound Yarn 1 skein each:

Espresso (MC)
Lace (A)
Claret (B)
Black (C), few yarns for embroidery

- Crochet hook size US G/6 or size to obtain gauge
- Split-ring stitch marker
- Yarn needle
- Fiberfill stuffing
- Two I/2" black buttons for eyes
- Row counter (optional)

Gauge is not critical for this project; in single crochet, 21 sts and 22 rows $=4$ ".

Abbreviations:
Inc: (increase) Work 2 sc in same st.
Dec: (decrease) Sc2tog (single crochet 2 sts together).

Stitches used: Chain (ch); single crochet (sc)

Notes:
All pieces are worked in-the-round; place a marker at beg of rnd and move up each rnd - do NOT join at the end of each round.

Stuff pieces firmly as you work; if stuffing is showing through piece, change to a smaller hook, or work with a firmer tension.

## DIRECTIONS:

Head/body
Beg at top of head, using A, chain 2.
Rnd 1 : Work 6 sc in second ch from hook - 6 sc.
Shape Head: Rnd 2: Inc in each st around by working 2 sc in each st-12 sc.
Rnd 3 : Inc 6 sts evenly around by *sc, inc; repeat from * around -18 sc.
Rnds 4 and 5 : Working 1 more st between increases each rnd, inc 6 sts on each rnd -30 sc .
Rnds $6,8,11$ and 13 : Work even (sc in each st around).
Rnds $7,9,10$ and 12 : Inc 6 sts evenly each rnd -54 sc .
Fasten off A; join MC with sc in ony st.
Rnds 14-27: Work even.
Shape Body: Rnds 28 and 29: Inc 6 sts evenly each rnd -66 sc.
Rnds 30 - 6 : Work even.
Shape Lower Body: Rnd 67: Dec 6 sts evenly around by *sc in next 9 sts, sc2tog - 60 sc.
Rnds 68-75: Working 1 less st less between decreases each rnd, dec 6 sts evenly each rnd - 12 sc rem.
Rnds 76 and 77: [Sc2tog] around - 3 sc rem. Fasten off.

## Muzzle

Using A, chain 8 .
Rnd I : Work 3 sc in second ch from hook (corner), sc in next 5 ch, work 3 sc in last ch (corner); working in rem loops on opposite side of beg ch, sc in same 5 ch as firsts side - 16 sc.

Rnd 2: [Inc in each st of 3 -st corner group, scin next 5 sts$]$ twice -22 sc .
Rnd 3: [llnc in next st, sc in next st, inc in next 2 sts, sc in next st, inc in next st) of 6 -st corner group, sc in next 5 sts] twice - 30 sc.
Rnd 4: Work even.
Rnd 5: *Sc in next 2 sts, work 2 sc in next st; rep from * around, end sc in next 2 sts-40 sc.
Rnds 6 - 8 : Work even. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for attaching.

Ears (make 2)
Rnds 1 - 4: Work Rnds 1 - 4 of Head - 24 sc. Fasten off.
Joining/Edging Row: Fold piece in half; using MC, working through both thicknesses, *sc in next st, work 2 sc in next st; rep from * around outer edge of piece, joining open edges. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for attaching.

Arms, Legs, Tail (make 5)
Rnds 1-4: Work Rnds 1-4 of Head - 24 sc.
Rnds 5 - 13: Work even.
Fasten off A; join MC with sc in any st.
Rnds 14 - 58: Work even.
Rnd 59: Fold piece flat; working through both thicknesses, ch 1, sc across. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for attaching.

## Finishing (use photo as a guide)

Hair: Cut four 4 " lengths of B and attach to top of Head between sts of Rnd 1. Muzzle: Using B, embroider mouth; using C, embroider nostrils. Stuff Muzzle and sew to front of Head. Ears and Eyes: Sew Ears to side of Head; sew on button eyes. Leg, Arms and Tail: Sew on Body as shown in photo.
Using yarn needle, weave in ends.
