

Skill level 1 Fleece Flowered Scarf

Supplies:

• Fleece:

1/4 yard red and blue plaid or print 1/8 yard each of red, blue and green solid

Scraps of pink and light blue

- Therm-O-Web[®] HeatnBond[®] Ultrahold Iron-On Adhesive
- Therm-O-Web® Pressing Paper
- Six round shank buttons, about 7/8" diameter
- Green pearl cotton thread, size 5
- Matching sewing threads
- Beacon Fabri-Tac[™] permanent adhesive

Directions:

- 1. Cut an 8" x 60" strip from fleece for scarf.
- 2. Cut red, blue and green fleece in half and bond two layers together with HeatnBond[®]. Follow manufacturer's directions, but place fleece on towel while using iron and use Pressing Paper between iron and fleece. It may be necessary to increase the iron times for a complete bond. Let fleece cool before using it.

Tools:

Terrycloth towel

• Basic sewing supplies

- 3. From prepared fleece: Cut 24 red petals, 12 blue petals, and 12 green leaves (see pattern for design template).
- 4. For each flower, use doubled thread to gather along the base of six petals in a continuous line and join the last petal to the first. Pull on the thread to gather petals into a circle; knot and clip the thread. Repeat to make a total of 4 red and 2 blue flowers.
- 5. For center, cut four 1-3/4" circles from pink and two from light blue fleece. Sew gathering stitches around the edge of each circle; insert shank button and pull thread to gather fleece around shank. Glue pink centers to the red flowers and light blue to the blue flowers.
- 6. If desired, embellish leaves with four fly stitches sewn down the center of each leaf with pearl cotton thread. Bury knots between layers.
- 7. To each end of the scarf, glue two red and one blue flower, and five leaves.
