

## **Ribbon Purse**

Here's a fashion handbag project that anyone can handle! And you don't have to know how to sew to get spectacular results!

## **SUPPLIES & TOOLS:**

- Canvas tote, size of your choice
- 3 Coordinating woven ribbons, 5 to 8 yds total (varies depending on size of tote and width of ribbon)
- Purse handles
- Fabri-Tac® adhesive or basic sewing supplies
- · Measuring tape
- Scissors

## **DIRECTIONS:**

- 1. Cut strips of ribbon that will fit horizontally around tote: two of color A one of color B.
- 2. Sew or glue ribbons across tote, alternating colors in A, B, A
- 3. Using color C and color B ribbons, cut strips that will fit vertically around tote. Alternate colors to form a design.
- 4. Sew or glue ribbon to tote.
- 5. For the handles, cut straps off canvas tote. Cut four 3" strips of ribbon, loop each through the ends of the handles and attach to the inside of the tote.

Skill level: No experience needed Crafting time: 1 hour plus drying time
